IMPORTANT NOTE

Carefully read through this entire instruction manual thoroughly before attempting to install this part.

Actual product may differ from photos. Installation will remain the same.

IMPORTANT NOTE

This Shower Awning is designed to be used in fair weather. Heavy wind, rain, or snow will cause damage

Always use tiedowns and stakes, even if winds are not expected.

WARNING

Park vehicle on flat surface, chock all four wheels and engage parking brake prior to installation.

Serious injury can occur when working on vehicles alone. When possible, work with another person to reduce risk of injury from strain or other dangers that can occur when working alone.

The following tools will be required to complete the installation of this part:





Installation Instructions: Shower Awning Installation



Step 1:

Remove the awning and hardware from its packaging. Lay the awning facing down on a clean worksurface. Open one side of the backside Velcro cover to reveal the start of the bolt tracks. Install (2) 6mm-1.0x25mm bolts per track and slide them towards the center of the awning. Then, close the Velcro cover. The bolts will still be loose in the track to allow for adjustment. This is normal.



Step 2:

Find a suitable mounting location for the shower awning. Make sure that the top of the awning is between 63-83" from the ground. Then, using the included (2) 8mm U-bolts, (4) 8mm nuts, (4) split lock washers, and (4) 8mm flat washers mount the L-brackets to your roof rack. Do the same for the other L-bracket. The L-brackets must be 18"-40" apart for proper mounting.

Note: This **Shower Awning** is designed to be mounted to an existing roof rack, such as a **Defender Rack** or an **SRC Roof Rack**. It will work with most tubular and square roof racks.



Step 3:

Slide the bolts along the rail until it matches up with both **L-brackets**. Then with the help of another person, carefully lift the **Shower Awning** into place. Then, install (2) 6mm flat washers and (2) 6mm nylock nuts as shown to hold the awning in place. Torque the bolts down using the torque guide on page 8

Installation is now complete.



Installation Instructions: Shower Awning Setup



Step 1:

Release both **Yellow Straps** holding the awning into place. Careful when removing the second strap as the awning will begin unrolling itself.

Note: Straps in photos are shown as red. Straps on your awning will be yellow.



Step 2:

With the awning unrolled, grab the top support arm and pull it out and to the left until it locks into place. Then, grab the bottom arm and pull it out and to the right until it locks into place. Be sure the hinges completely lock into place by ensuring the pin is inside the grove.



Step 3:

Unroll the roof section by unhooking the straps. Unroll outwards until you reach the edge of the awning. Then, secure all 6 Velcro straps to the support arms. Be sure the corners of the roof wrap around the support bars as shown.

Be sure to use the included **Stakes** to tie to bottom straps down. Setup is now complete.



Installation Instructions: Shower Awning Use



Shower Head Straps:

Located between the yellow awning retention straps are a pair of straps made to hold the shower head of a portable shower.



Shower Head Mounting:

Different portable shower kits will have different style shower heads. These straps will work with most shower head configurations. Some adjustments may have to be made to find the setup that works best for you.

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Installation Instructions: Shower Awning Teardown



Step 1:

Remove tiedowns from stakes, then remove the stakes from the ground. Be sure to clean the stakes, then return them to the storage bag.

Be sure the awning is completely dry prior to beginning the teardown process.

Remove all 6 Velcro straps holding the roof to the support bars. Then roll the roof up and secure using the hook straps.



Step 2:

Start from the right side of the awning, push the right support bar slightly outward, this will disengage the locking hinge and allow the arm to fold inward. Fold the right arm in, then repeat for the left arm.



Step 3:

With both sides folded in, start at the bottom of the awning, begin tightly rolling the awning up. Then, secure the rolled awning with the yellow straps.

Fold the travel cover over top of the rolled up awning and zip the cover closed.


Teardown is now complete.




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
